

Department of Greek Life & University Events Standards Code
Article V - Standards Procedure Flow Chart A

Written report and evidence received by the Department of Greek Life & University Events within 30 days of accused incident

All reports sent to the Office of Student Conduct and chapter's national office, Chapter consultant, and/or regional representative

Standards Board and Advisors meet within one week after receipt of written report

University may take immediate disciplinary action

Standards Board, along with advisors meets to discuss and decide to refer the case to appropriate constituencies

The Office of Student conduct for mediation or hazing case

Chapter's respective council

Administrative Hearing

If chapter fails to uphold any requirements from mediation, the report and case will automatically be sent to a Standards Hearing

Should the report be sent to the chapter's respective council, the council must follow its respective Constitution and Bylaws regarding judicial procedures

The chapter's respective council has the option to refer the report back to the Standards Board for a Standards Hearing

A Standards Hearing must occur to determine if a chapter is responsible or not for the alleged violation

Chapter is found not responsible

Chapter is found responsible

No future discussion of allegations

Chapter has the right to appeal - Appeals must be made in writing to the Assistant Vice President of of Student Affairs within 10 days of the date of the issued sanction letter

Sanction process begins
