Greek Week 2011 Rules

1. HAVE FUN... this is the time for all of us to bond and come together as one. Let's show this school what we are made of!!!
2. There will be NO alcohol, drugs, or other controlled substances at any Greek Week related events (including practices, meetings, etc.). Violations of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the event or week as determined by the Greek Life Staff.
3. Chapter Greek Week representatives must be present at all Greek Week meetings and activities. It will be your responsibility to obtain any information you miss.
4. Although we encourage ideas and input, all decisions made by the Greek Week Staff are final.
5. Any deadline not met will result in loss of points and/or fine.
6. Please remember that you are the liaison between the Greek Week Staff and your chapter/team. Please relay all information in a **timely** and **accurate** manner.
7. The Greek Life Office reserves the right to make changes and qualifying decisions at any point prior to, during, and post Greek Week.
8. All rules for Greek Week activities put forth in their description must be followed.
9. If rules are broken during any Greek Week event the team could lose points or be disqualified from Greek Week by the discretion of the Greek Life Office Staff.

Monday, March 28, 2011

∂ Day Event: Paint the Town Blue – 8:00am to 5:00pm

- Each team will go to assigned locations around Arlington between 8:00am and 5:00pm and tag the business with UTA School Spirit paraphernalia and/or Greek Spirit paraphernalia.
- A list of locations will be provided by Greek Life before Greek Week begins Monday morning via email.
- Take pairing pictures at the locations for spirit points. Be creative.
- Must have at least 1 person from each organization in pairing in picture to receive points
- Each photo taken at a different location (only one photo per location) will earn the group 10 points. (Location name, UTA School Spirit paraphernalia and/or Greek Spirit paraphernalia must be in picture)
- Each team must submit photos via email to Greeklife@uta.edu by 6:00pm to receive points.

∂ Night Event: Parking Lot Painting Party – 5:00pm- 7:00pm

- Pairings will bring their cars to the parking lot by the MAC (West Lawn) to paint car windows for publicity and spirit points.
- Car must be painted with to reflect pairing theme.
- Cars will be decorated and painted by pairing members.
- Each pairing selects 1 car that will be judged for Greek Week points.
- Each group may bring up to five extra cars (not including the one being judged) and decorate them with UTA and Greek Life spirit for 25 points per car.
- Judges will base points on overall appearance and relevance to the pairing decade. The points will be distributed as follows:
 - 1st place will receive 150 points
 - 2nd place will receive 100 points
 - 3rd place will receive 50 points

Tuesday, March 29, 2011

o Day Event: Chalking and CANstruction Competition - 11:00am- 2:00pm

- o **Chalking Competition:**
- o Chalking designs may be related to UTA, Greek Life, and/or pairing decade.
- o Location: (TBD)
- o The judges will use the following scoring scale to determine pairing points:
 - 50 points for incorporation of UTA, Greek Life and/or decade creativity
 - 30 points for creativity
 - 20 points for artistic ability
- o The groups will be ranked by the points that they have received from the above scoring scale based on the point scale below.
 - 1st place will receive 150 points
 - 2nd place will receive 100 points
 - 3rd place will receive 50 points

- o **CANstruction Competition:**
- o Groups may collect cans (non-perishable items only) up until the event begins. The public may also bring cans to support the event.
- o Each group must bring the cans that they have collected to the event in boxes.
- o The competition portion of this event will be exactly 20 minutes and the groups may not begin constructing until the time begins.
- o Up to 15 members from each pairing may participate in this event.
- o The judges will use the following scoring scale to determine pairing points:
 - 50 points for creativity
 - 50 points for the incorporation of the pairing decade
- o The groups will be ranked by the points that they have received from the above scoring scale based on the point scale below.
 - 1st place will receive 150 points
 - 2nd place will receive 100 points
 - 3rd place will receive 50 points

Tuesday, March 29, 2011

- o **Night Event: Student Affairs Baseball Tailgate – 5:00pm- 7:00pm**
 - o Each pairing will provide decade themed Mocktails.
 - o Pairings will receive points for dressing in UTA attire at the Baseball Tailgate.
 - o Pairings will receive 10 points for every person dressed in UTA attire (100 points max)
 - o Mocktails may contain NO ALCOHOL. Pairings will be automatically disqualified if alcohol is used.
 - o The judges will use the following scoring scale to determine pairing points:
 - 50 points for taste
 - 30 points for creativity
 - 20 points for the incorporation of the pairing decade
 - o The groups will be ranked by the points that they have received from the above scoring scale based on the point scale below.
 - 1st place will receive 150 points
 - 2nd place will receive 100 points
 - 3rd place will receive 50 points

Wednesday, March 30, 2011

∂ **Day Event: Fashion Show – 12:00pm**

- Location: TBD
- 4 people from each pairing will participate
- 2 girls and 2 guys from each group must participate
- Participants may be dressed in attire from their decade. Attire must be appropriate.
- Descriptions of outfits must be submitted to the Greek Life by Tuesday, March 29 at 5:00pm.
- The judges will use the following scoring scale to determine pairing points:
 - 25 points per person on attire
 - 25 points per person on attitude and crowd interaction
- The groups will be ranked by the points that they have received from the above scoring scale based on the point scale below.
 - 1st place will receive 150 points
 - 2nd place will receive 100 points
 - 3rd place will receive 50 points

∂ **Night Event: Intramural Games – Time:TBD**

- There will be three games: Wiffleball, Goalball, and Wolleyball
- Each game must have different participants. No person may play in multiple games.
- Game rules will be provided at the event

Thursday, March 31, 2011

∂ Day Event: Blast from the past – 11:00am-2:00pm

- Pairing will provide food to give away to the campus community.
- Pairings will use decade inspired ideas to decorate table

- 20's, 50's and 60's will be in charge of serving finger foods, and 70's, 80's, and 90's will be in charge of serving desserts.

∂ Night Event: UTA Bandstand – 8:00pm-10:00pm

- Location: Rio Grande
- This will be a dance competition between the different pairings.
- The pairings will pick a dance from their decade prior to the competition and rehearse on their own time.
- The dance that the group chooses to do must be turned into the Greek Life office by Monday, March 28th by 5pm.
- The groups must perform the dance from their decade with as many members from the group as desired.
- The dance must be appropriate and be from their decade.
- The judges will use the following scoring scale to determine pairing points:
 - 50 points for performance and ability to duplicate the dance
 - 30 points for enthusiasm
 - 30 points for creativity
- The groups will be ranked by the points that they have received from the above scoring scale based on the point scale below.
 - 1st place will receive 150 points
 - 2nd place will receive 100 points
 - 3rd place will receive 50 points
