Parent & Family Weekend Event

This year, Fraternity & Sorority Life will host an event called Baby Strolls during Parent & Family Weekend. The Baby Strolls Show is a new take on Baby Steps, which was held during Parent & Family Weekend featuring the entire UT Arlington Greek in the past. This year's show will take place on October 21, 2011 at 7:30pm in the Rosebud Theater. Teams (i.e. no more than 21 people/team) composed of members from IFC, MGC, PHC, and NPHC compete for a cash prize to be awarded to a local philanthropy of their choice. Sororities stroll with sororities and fraternities with fraternities. All proceeds from the show must benefit local Arlington philanthropies.

Each team must perform and be judged on the seven (7) items listed below. Shows should last no longer than eight (8) minutes from the first stroll to the end of the show. Faculty/staff members and alumni/ae will serve as judges for the show. There is no entry fee for this event.

- **Stroll/Strut On**- Each team must find an exciting, interesting, and creative way to get onto the stage. (Time begins with the first stroll a team performs)
- **General Stroll**- All teams will perform this stroll during their show. Teams may cater the stroll in their performance as they see fit. The more creative this stroll, the better.
- **Transitions**- Each team must create smooth transitions from one stroll to another. This can be a step, a chant, etc.
- **Theme/Skit**- Each team must incorporate a skit into their show. The more people a team involves in the skit, the better.
- **Costume**
- **Crowd Response**
- **Stroll/Strut Off**- Each team must find an exciting, interesting, and creative way to exit the stage. (Time ends once last person leaves the stage)

The Baby Strolls Show will be held in the Rosebud Theatre. Tickets for the event will be \$5.00 for everyone. All performers in the event and all participants in Parent & Family Weekend will be given free admittance. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams. The more tickets we sell for this event and the more the Greek community aids in promoting this event, the higher the prize money will be for the winning teams. Prize amounts will be determined

Disqualification

Participating Organizations may be disqualified and/or eliminated from the competition by Fraternity & Sorority Life Staff for the following, but not limited to:

- Including material that violates or infringes on another's rights (privacy, publicity, intellectual property or that constitutes copyright infringement)
- Including material that promotes discrimination, is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortuous, defamatory, slanderous or libelous
- Including material that is unlawful or in violation of the laws of the state, UT Arlington, and/or Fraternity & Sorority Life
- Use of prohibited/inappropriate calls, language or hand signals
- Ridiculing/Dissing/Bad Mouthing other fraternities or sororities
- Any dance or step including nudity, partial nudity, gyrating or simulating sexual activity, or sexually suggestive movements
- Profanity, including any word, expression, gesture or other behavior that is socially construed or interpreted as insulting, rude, vulgar or disrespectful
- Use of any component that is in poor taste or contains profanity or sexually explicit language or connotations
- Performing or appearing to perform under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Wearing inappropriate attire. All clothing should be clean, properly fitting and in good repair and meet the following requirements:
 - Strapless, halter or tube tops, clothing cannot expose the midsection, abdominal area or, low-cut clothing, transparent clothing and very short skirts are not allowed.
 - All undergarments, including briefs/boxers and sports bras, must be properly covered by outer clothing
 - Attire must not display obscene, profane, illegal, inappropriate or offensive images or words, including references to alcohol, tobacco, drug usage or violence.
